

## **VETERANS INFORMATION**

Applications Now Being Accepted for 2024-2025 VFW-SVA Legislative Fellowship: The application process for the 2024-2025 class of VFW-SVA legislative fellows is now open. VFW members who attend an accredited institute of higher learning will be chosen for the semester-long program that focuses on real policy issues faced by veterans, service members, and their families. The capstone of the program is participation in the 2025 VFW Legislative Conference in Washington, D.C. Alumni of the program have become more active at all levels of the VFW and SVA, and have been instrumental in changing laws to improve care and benefits for veterans.

VA Redesigns Burn Pit Registry: VA has released a Redesigned Airborne Hazards and Open Burn Pit Registry, called AHOBPR 2.0, to better identify and investigate adverse health conditions typically attributed to airborne hazards and burn pits exposure. New features include broader participation criteria, clear opt-out procedures, and automatic registration based on DOD records. While enrollment in AHOBPR 2.0 does not influence a veteran's health care or benefits, the data collected will help VA develop more advanced treatments, use more precise predictive medicine, make better informed decisions pertaining to presumptive conditions, and deliver targeted proactive and preventive care.

Apply Now for New VA Graduate Medical Education Program: VA has launched an online portal for applications to a new pilot program through which it will reimburse salaries and benefits for at least 100 physician residents who rotate to covered health care facilities. For nearly 80 years, VA has impacted the next generation of health professionals with almost 70% of U.S. physicians having trained at VA. "This program will place physician residents where they are needed most, in rural and underserved communities across America. For veterans, this program will make it easier to access the health care they need and deserve," said VA Chief Academic Affiliations Officer Marjorie Bowman, M.D.

Participate in VA Million Veteran Program and Improve Care for All: When veterans maintain positive relationships, stay physically active, and manage stress, it benefits their overall health. By joining VA's <u>Million Veteran Program</u>, you can help researchers better understand veterans' physical and mental health.

## **BATTLE OF THE MONTH**



## Battles of Saratoga

The **Battles of Saratoga** (September 19 and October 7, 1777) marked the climax of the <u>Saratoga campaign</u>, giving a decisive victory to the Americans over the British in the <u>American Revolutionary War</u>. British General <u>John Burgoyne</u> led an invasion army of 7,200–8,000 men southward from Canada in the <u>Champlain Valley</u>, hoping to meet a similar British force marching northward from New York City and another British force marching eastward from <u>Lake Ontario</u>; the goal was to take <u>Albany</u>, <u>New York</u>. The southern and western forces never arrived, and Burgoyne was surrounded by American forces in upstate New York 15 miles (24 km) short of his goal. He fought two battles which took place 18 days apart on the same ground 9 miles (14 km) south of <u>Saratoga</u>, <u>New York</u>. He gained a victory in the first battle despite being outnumbered, but lost the second battle after the Americans returned with an even larger force.

Burgoyne found himself trapped by much larger American forces with no relief, so he retreated to Saratoga (now <u>Schuylerville</u>) and surrendered his entire army there on October 17. His surrender, says historian <u>Edmund Morgan</u>, "was a great turning point of the war because it won for Americans the foreign assistance which was the last element needed for victory."

Burgoyne's <u>strategy</u> to divide <u>New England</u> from the southern colonies had started well but slowed due to logistical problems. He won a small tactical victory over American General <u>Horatio Gates</u> and the <u>Continental Army</u> in the September 19 <u>Battle of Freeman's Farm</u> at the cost of significant casualties. His gains were erased when he again attacked the Americans in the October 7 <u>Battle of Bemis Heights</u> and the Americans captured a portion of the British defenses. Burgoyne was therefore compelled to retreat, and his army was surrounded by the much larger American force at Saratoga, forcing him to surrender on October 17. News of Burgoyne's surrender was instrumental in formally bringing France into the war as an American ally, although it had previously given <u>supplies</u>, <u>ammunition</u>, <u>and guns</u>, notably the <u>de Valliere</u> cannon which played an important role in Saratoga.

The battle on September 19 began when Burgoyne moved some of his troops in an attempt to <u>flank</u> the entrenched American position on Bemis Heights. American Major General <u>Benedict Arnold</u> anticipated the maneuver and placed significant forces in his way. Burgoyne did gain control of Freeman's Farm, but it came at the cost of significant casualties. Skirmishing continued in the days following the battle, while Burgoyne waited in the hope that reinforcements would arrive from New York City. Patriot militia forces continued to arrive, meanwhile, swelling the size of the American army. Disputes within the American camp led Gates to strip Arnold of his command.

British General <u>Sir Henry Clinton</u> moved up from New York City and attempted to divert American attention by capturing <u>Forts Clinton and Montgomery</u> in the Hudson River highlands on October 6, and <u>Kingston</u> on October 13, but his efforts were too late to help Burgoyne. Burgoyne attacked Bemis Heights again on October 7 after it became apparent that he would not receive relieving aid in time. This battle culminated in heavy fighting marked by Arnold's spirited rallying of the American troops. Burgoyne's forces were thrown back to the positions that they held before the September 19 battle, and the Americans captured a portion of the entrenched British defenses.
