## **VETERANS INFORMATION**

VFW Hosts Veterans Justice Commission: The VFW Washington, D.C., office hosted the Veterans Justice Commission to discuss the work it does to examine the extent and nature of veteran involvement in the criminal justice system, and to develop recommendations for evidence-based policy changes that can enhance safety, health, and judicial fairness. VFW National Legislative Director Pat Murray moderated a panel presentation with former Secretary of Defense Chuck Hagel and Commission Director Jim Seward during which they presented both state and federal policy proposals.

**VFW Meets with Congressional Hispanic Caucus:** VFW Post 7420 Commander Livier "Livy" Lizaro from San Diego addressed the House Congressional Hispanic Caucus during a roundtable focused on the challenges faced by Hispanic veterans and their families. The event brought together experts and stakeholders to discuss the issues affecting Hispanic service members and veterans nationwide. Lizaro highlighted the VFW's support for deported and repatriated veterans who were unable to naturalize during their service and emphasized the need for Congress to pass the TAP Promotion Act, ensuring all transitioning service members have access to accredited representatives for VA claims assistance before discharge.

VFW Responds to The Economist: VFW National Legislative Director Pat Murray publicly posted a vehement response to a poorly written and unattributed article titled, "American Veterans Now Receive Absurdly Generous Benefits," published by *The Economist*. Murray said, "I'd challenge the anonymous cowards at The Economist to illuminate us on which parts of veterans' healthcare and benefits are inappropriate, illogical, or wildly unreasonable?"

Reminder for VA Secure Sign In: VA has issued changes for signing into your VA.gov or My HealtheVet accounts. Currently, there are four ways to sign in to your VA accounts: LOGIN.GOV, ID.ME, My HealtheVet, and DS Logon. Both My HealtheVet and DS Logon will be discontinued for accessing VA accounts. My HealtheVet sign in will be available until Jan. 31, 2025. Veterans, family members, caregivers, and survivors with VA accounts are encouraged to transition how they sign in to access these accounts prior to that date.

## **BATTLE OF THE MONTH**



# Battle of Tucapel

Tucapel fort was located on a hill in the coastal mountain range. In December 1553, <u>Mapuche</u> forces, under the command of the vice <u>toqui</u> <u>Lautaro</u> attacked and destroyed the fort using the battle tactics learned from the Spanish. <u>Pedro de Valdivia</u> had left <u>Concepción</u> with only 50 soldiers and sent a message to Purén fort to send reinforcements. The message, however, was intercepted by Lautaro's men.

Valdivia received no reports from his leading element, and spent the night a half <u>day's journey</u> from Tucapel. On <u>Christmas Day</u>, December 25, 1553, he left early in the morning for the fort, arriving in its vicinity with silence reigning. He found it completely destroyed. Neither Gómez de Almagro nor Bobadilla was anywhere to be found. He decided to make camp amidst the damp ruins of the fort, but the contingent had hardly begun to make preparations when there were shouts from the surrounding forest. Without advance warning, a mass of Mapuche warriors charged out towards the Spanish enclave.

A veteran soldier, Valdivia had time to form and arm his defensive line and repulsed the first attack. The cavalry charged upon the rearguard of the retreating Mapuche force, but the Indians were prepared for this action and reversed the charge with <u>lances</u>. However, with much valor and resolution the Spaniards managed to drive back the resulting Mapuche surge into the forest. The Spaniards savored their temporary victory.

There was still more to come, however. A second squadron of Mapuches attacked, this time armed with <u>maces</u> and ropes as well as lances, with which they succeeded in dismounting the unfortunate Spanish <u>caballeros</u>, whom they quickly dragged out of the battlefield once they were on the ground. The Spanish managed to drive them back, but not without leaving many fallen. Then a third group of Mapuches appeared, this time with Lautaro behind it.

Valdivia, aware of the desperate situation due to the Spanish losses and fatigue, gathered together his available men and threw himself into the bitter fight. Already half of the Spanish forces were casualties and the Indian auxiliaries were steadily being reduced. Valdivia, seeing that the fight was lost, ordered the retreat, but Lautaro himself came around the flank and sealed the Spanish fate. The Indians felled every one of the Spaniards, and only Valdivia and the cleric Pozo, who rode the best horses, were able to escape. However, when crossing the swamps the men became bogged down and the Mapuches eventually captured them.
