VETERANS INFORMATION

VFW Meets with House Committee Chairman: VFW Washington Office Executive Director Ryan Gallucci and National Legislative Director Kristina Keenan met with House Committee on Veterans' Affairs Chairman Mike Bost to discuss the VFW's legislative priorities and our call to Honor the Contract to ensure that veterans receive the benefits they have earned and deserve as promised in military service contracts. They expressed support for bills introduced by the chairman, such as H.R. 740, Veterans' ACCESS Act of 2025, and H.R. 1041, Veterans 2nd Amendment Protection Act. The VFW looks forward to continuing work with Chairman Bost on these proposals and other important pieces of veteran legislation during the 119th Congress.

Senate Hearing on Future at VA: The Senate Committee on Veterans' Affairs held an oversight hearing with Secretary Douglas Collins on the future at VA. Collins emphasized the need for reforms to better provide health care and benefits to veterans, and confirmed his commitment to reduce wasteful spending. He stated he would keep mission-essential jobs and phase out nonessential roles with the goal of a 15 percent reduction, and work to eliminate inefficiencies to reduce appointment wait times and the number of pending claims.

VA Announces Survivor Benefits Reforms: The VFW applauds the decision by VA to move the Office of Survivors Assistance from the Veterans Benefits Administration to the Office of the VA Secretary. The VFW has advocated for this change over the last few years through congressional testimony. This decision will bring more focus on improving outreach and coordination of the full range of survivor benefits provided by VA.

VFW Honors Family of Missing WWII Airman: More than 80 years after his plane was shot down over Germany, the remains of WWII Army Air Forces Staff Sergeant Hubert Yeary have been laid to rest at Arlington National Cemetery in Arlington, Virginia. VFW Junior Vice Commander Tim Peters was in attendance with Kelly McKeague, director of the Defense POW/MIA Accounting Agency (DPAA), who oversees the agency's mission of fullest possible recovery, identification, and repatriation of the remains of our missing personnel. Peters offered condolences and presented a VFW memento to Yeary's family members. DPAA's mission to never leave a fallen comrade behind remains a top priority for the VFW.

BATTLE OF THE MONTH




Battle of Cold Harbor

The **Battle of Cold Harbor** was fought during the <u>American Civil War</u> near <u>Mechanicsville, Virginia</u>, from May 31 to June 12, 1864, with the most significant fighting occurring on June 3. It was one of the final battles of <u>Union Lt. Gen. Ulysses S. Grant</u>'s <u>Overland Campaign</u>, and is remembered as one of American history's most lopsided battles. Thousands of Union soldiers were killed or wounded in the frontal assault of June 3 against the fortified positions of <u>Confederate Gen. Robert E. Lee</u>'s army, an event that compounded the image of Grant's apparent disregard for high casualties.

On May 31, as Grant's army once again swung around the right flank of Lee's army, Union caval-ry seized the crossroads of Old Cold Harbor, about 10 miles northeast of the Confederate capital of Richmond, Virginia, holding it against Confederate attacks until the Union infantry arrived. Both Grant and Lee, whose armies had suffered enormous casualties in the Overland Campaign, received reinforcements. On the evening of June 1, the Union VI Corps and XVIII Corps arrived and assaulted the Confederate works to the west of the crossroads with some success.

On June 2, the remaining forces of both armies arrived, and the Confederate troops constructed an extensive series of fortifications extending seven miles. At dawn on June 3, three Union corps launched an assault on the Confederate defenses at the southern end of the line. The attack was easily repelled, resulting in significant casualties for the Union forces. Attempts to assault the northern end of the line and to resume the assaults on the southern were unsuccessful. The armies confronted each other on these lines until the night of June 12, when the Army of the Potomac finally disengaged.




